Open Forum



The first Open Forum for the academic year 2017-18 was conducted on 29th August, 2017. 113 Students from Shift-I and 144 students from Shift-II attended the Open forum.

The second Open Forum for the academic year 2017-18 was conducted on 24th January, 2018. 109 students from Shift-I and 140 students from Shift-II attended the Open Forum. All officials of the college were present to listen to the queries of the students and provided the platform to have an interface between students and administrators.

The UGC sponsored State Level Seminar on Quality Assurance and Accreditation was organized on 2nd March, 2018.



IQAC Coordinators and Extended IQAC members from 36 institutions and 42 Extended IQAC members of Loyola attended the seminar. The seminar gave an opportunity to IQAC coordinators and Extended IQAC members to deliberate on building a quality culture in Higher Education institutions and to get better understanding on the new framework and process of NAAC accreditation. Dr.A.Xavier Mahimairaj, IQAC Coordinator, Loyola College and the Convener of the seminar explained the Dynamics of the seminar. Rev. Fr. Christie P. Maria Joseph,S.J., Director, LIBA. The chief guest of the seminar enlightened the participants on “Challenges and Opportunities in Higher Education in India.” Dr.B.S.Ponmudiraj, Deputy (Academic) Northern Region& Regional Coordinator (i/c), Eastern Region, NAAC, Bangalore explained the “New Methodology of NAAC Assessment to Nurture Quality Assurance and Enhancement in Higher Education Institutions”. The erudite panelists shared their insights on building a quality culture in higher education institution viz Dr.L.S.Ganesh, Professor, Department of Management Studies,IIT, Madras spoke on “Building Quality Culture in Curriculum Development and Evaluation”, Dr.Sridhar Ganesh, Managing Director & CEO, Adrenalin eSystems Limited, enlightened us on “Building Quality Culture in our approaches of Teaching and Learning Methodologies.” and Dr.T.Thyagarajan, Professor, Department of Instrumentation Engineering, MIT Campus, Anna University, shared his thoughts on “Building Quality Culture in Research and Governance”. The participants were highly appreciative of the one day deliberation on the theme.

Various feedback mechanisms were administered by IQAC viz Staff Evaluation, Staff Appraisal, Feedback from parents and outgoing students. These reports were collated and given to the management to take appropriate steps to enhance the quality of the performance of the college.

Through various measures IQAC continues to be an important component of Loyola which ensures quality and continuous improvement in all aspects of the college. It places on record its sincere appreciation and gratitude to all the extended IQAC members, Quality circle members and the core team of IQAC for their dedicated service.

Extended IQAC Meeting: The IQAC regularly meeting with the External IQAC members of each department each academic year. One meeting was conducted on 3rd July, 2017 and another meeting was conducted on 23rd January 2018.
